- Understanding what the victims go through, and why they sometimes choose to stay
- The hierarchy and structure human traffickers use to maintain order in their underground world
- ◆ Common terminology, phrases, slang, and "branding" techniques used by traffickers and victims
- ◆ Discuss cases involving actual human trafficking victims
