Friends of Tiny Hearts is a group of passionate NICU graduate families, friends and staff members committed to supporting families on their NICU journey and improving the outstanding care available at the UC Medical Center. The organization works to raise money for research and to raise awareness of premature birth and NICU care – yet their primary focus is on providing assistance to families who are grappling with the challenges of a premature birth.

"One of the most important things a baby in the NICU can have is a parent or family member by his or her side," says Elaine, one of the founding members of Friends. "But the sad reality is that many parents and families can't maintain a constant presence no matter how badly they want to be there. Things like taking time off work, arranging care for other children and making long trips to be in the NICU present major hardships. And many families simply don't have the resources to do that, which can create feelings of guilt on top of the emotions they are already experiencing."

Contributions raised through Friends of Tiny Hearts support these families in a variety of ways – fuel cards to support long-distance journeys, hotel accommodations, and supplies needed for the baby once he or she is discharged from the NICU. These resources help reduce the stress parents and families are under and allow them to focus on their baby or babies.

In the two years since Friends of Tiny Hearts was formed, more than \$30,000 has been raised to help families and enhance the facilities available to care givers and parents alike. The group is pleased with their progress, but endeavors to do much more in the years to come!
